**Academic:** Had his primary Education in Bandar Hilir English School and after that at St David's High School for his secondary education. He scored first Grades in the Lower Certificate of Education (LCE) and also the Malaysia Certificate of Education (MCE). After that he followed a Pre-University Course in ITM and came back for enrolment in the Double Maths class at The Malacca High School. After a short stint in the Lower Form Six he Accepted an offer to do Civil Engineering back in UiTM. Because he was a very active student leader in UiTM he was asked to continue his Education elsewhere after the students demonstration in 1974. He did his Foundation Level courses in Southampton College of Technology and Completed up to Professional Level II in Cost and Management Accountancy at the London School of Accountancy. He also attended Workshops, seminars and short courses organized by various training Centres from time to time.

**Career:** He started as an Accounts Officer in a Mara Holding subsidiary and later Promoted to its Accounts and Admin Manager and finally his last posting there was as the Accounts, Admin and Marketing Manager. He started to venture into business after that and was involved in Bakery, Automobile, Transportation, Construction, Trading, Information and Communication Technology, Aqua Culture and Services & Events Organization.

He was also special officer to four Chief Ministers of Melaka Tan Sri Rahim Tambychik(1992-1994), Datuk Mohd Zain Ghani (1994-1997), Datuk Seri Abu Zahar Ithnin (1997-1999) and Datuk Seri Hj Mohd Ali Rustam (1999-2001)

He was appointed a Councillor at the Majlis Perbandaran Melaka Bandaraya Bersejarah for three years in 1989, 1990 and 1991.
